



RETURN TO PLAY IN A COVID-SAFE ENVIRONMENT PLAN

INTRODUCTION

Canberra Grammar School (the School) is committed to ensuring the ongoing health, safety and wellbeing of its community during the COVID-19 pandemic.

This plan enables the School to participate in co-curricular sport during this time, whilst adhering to the current government restrictions relating to training and competition (ACT Roadmap Step 2.2+ effective from midday Friday 17 July).

The plan refers to training and competition events taking place at the Red Hill campus. It will remain flexible and acknowledge the broader principles relevant to each phase of easing of restrictions.

If unwell or showing any individual respiratory or cold/flu symptoms, even if mild, do not attend training or competitions. This applies to participants, coaches and spectators.

DATES

Primary School

- Winter Season concludes Term 3 Week 7 (Saturday 6 September); and
- Summer Season begins in Term 3 Week 8 (Monday 7 September).

Senior School

- Winter Season is to be recorded until end of the Term 3 (Saturday 26 September); and
- Summer Season for 2020 will coincide with the start of Term 4 (Monday 12 October).



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| <p>TRAINING</p> <p>PARTICIPANTS & COACHES</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not attend if unwell (participants to inform coach if feeling unwell immediately prior to session commencing/coaches to inform colleagues) • Participants may be asked to leave the session and present to the Health Clinic/be collected by a parent if they seem unwell and have been verbally assessed by a Coach • Full contact training is permitted under ACT Step 2.2+ • Hand sanitise before session starts and after session ends • ‘Get in, train, get out’ principle applied • No sharing of food or drinks • Bring own drinks bottle • Water bubblers – bottle refills only • Come ready to train • ‘Community sport approach’ applied, including adherence to any published, code-specific skill and conditioning frameworks • All equipment used must be wiped down before and after use • For larger groups, consider splitting into smaller groups; and • Cancellation protocols in place should a coach or participant become ill/symptomatic. |
| <p>TRAINING</p> <p>SPECTATORS</p> <p>INDOOR & OUTDOOR VENUES</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No spectators permitted • Max 100 people permitted or one person per 4sqm (whichever is lesser), including participants and coaches; and • Drop off and pick up only advised. |
| <p>COMPETITION</p> <p>PARTICIPANTS & COACHES</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not attend if unwell (participants to inform coach if feeling unwell immediately prior to session commencing/Coaches to inform colleagues) • Participants may be asked to leave the game and present to the Health Clinic/be collected by a parent if they seem unwell and have been verbally assessed by a Coach • Full contact is permitted • Hand sanitise before game starts and after game ends • No sharing of food or drinks • Bring own drinks bottle • Water bubblers – bottle refills only • Come ready to play; and • Cancellation protocols in place should a coach or participant(s) become ill/symptomatic. |



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| <p>COMPETITION</p> <p>SPECTATORS</p> <p>INDOOR & OUTDOOR VENUES</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Register at 'trace station' upon arrival (see attached maps for locations), providing name and phone number • Do not attend/leave immediately if unwell • Max 100 people permitted or one person per 4msq (whichever is lesser), including participants, Coaches and Spectators • Strictly one parent/carer per participant permitted (as a spectator); and • General public not permitted. |
| <p>ATTENDANCE</p> <p>ALL</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not participate or spectate if you: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Are unwell ○ Have been in close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19 ○ Have been tested and are awaiting results ○ Are an immediate family member of someone who is awaiting test results ○ Have recently returned from overseas or from a known, domestic COVID-19 Hotspot; or ○ Consider yourself a vulnerable person with pre-existing medical conditions. • Leave straight after training/competition game – no pre or post-game social activities will be permitted. |
| <p>HYGIENE</p> <p>ALL</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hand sanitise upon arrival at the venue • Wash hands with soap and water if you have to use the venue toilets • Use change room toilets only (participants) • Use adult toilets (Coaches and spectators only) • Do not share food or drinks • Bring your own full water bottle (especially participants) • Place any rubbish in the bins provided • Do not use contact greetings (eg high-fives, handshakes, hugging) • Get tested, even if you only have mild symptoms; and • If you haven't already done so, download the COVIDSafe App. |
| <p>SOCIAL/PHYSICAL DISTANCING</p> <p>ALL</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Observe the social/physical distancing signage at the venue (indoor and outdoor) • Maintain 1.5m distance apart; and • Leave straight after training/competition game – no pre or post-game social activities will be permitted. |



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| <p>CASE MANAGEMENT</p> <p>THE SCHOOL</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The School will be contacted by ACT Health if a confirmed case of COVID-19 is attributed to a CGS sporting fixture • Conversely, if the School becomes aware of a confirmed case prior to being notified, they must immediately contact ACT Health • All spectators – for competition fixtures, it is important to visit the ‘trace station’ upon arrival at the venue and leave your name and phone number • The School will immediately inform the opposition school/club should a confirmed case be identified as a result of a CGS-held sporting fixture; and • The School will keep records of any injured players, as this information may be required during contact tracing. |
| <p>REVIEW, MONITOR & UPDATE</p> <p>THE SCHOOL</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The School will continue to review, monitor and update all of its COVID-19 protocols, including this plan and in parallel with the ACT Roadmap Steps; and • The plan will be accessible from CGS Connect and the external CGS website (CGS.ACT.EDU.AU) |
